

2018/2019 THOMAS McGUINNESS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP



The Suffolk County Court Employees Association Scholarship Fund will be awarding **TEN (10) \$1,000.00** Scholarship awards to the family of an eligible student for the school year 2018/2019. **(Fall 2018 & Spring 2019)**. ***All scholarship award checks will be made payable to the college or university of the student.**

Students must be enrolled in college on a full-time basis (12 or more credits) for both the Fall, 2018, and Spring, 2019, semesters or Grad school (6 credits). Non-academic and trade schools do not qualify. Scholarships will be selected on a lottery basis.

The Union office must have on file proof of enrollment PER SEMESTER prior to the union meeting. Do not send S.A.T. scores or scholarship applications from any other organization with this form. **Acceptable proof of enrollment: Enrollment Certificate or Registration or Transcript or Student's Schedule. All proof must state school's name, child's name, semester currently enrolled.**

Only one (1) application will be accepted per individual student and only one student per family may win a scholarship, however, more than one eligible student per family may submit applications.

Applications and proof of enrollment must be received before the APRIL 11, 2019, General Membership Meeting, to enable us to check student's eligibility. Applicants must be children or grandchildren of active or retired members of the Suffolk County Court Employees Association whose parent(s) are responsible for the payment of college expenses
